## **STATE SENATE CANDIDATE TIM SCHOFIELD'S COMMUNITY MEET & GREET DRAWS 100**

*At Event, Schofield Endorsed by Reps. Moran and Honan, City Councilors Connolly and Ciommo, and Former Candidate Lawn.*

On Sunday, November 20th, State Senate candidate Tim Schofield hosted a campaign brunch and meet and greet for the Second Suffolk and Middlesex district community. The event was held at The Stockyard restaurant in Brighton.

State Representatives Mike Moran and Kevin Honan, Boston City Councilors John Connolly and Mark Ciommo, and former State Senate candidate Sheila Lawn all attended the event, which drew a crowd of one hundred.

At the event, Representatives Honan and Moran and Councilor Ciommo introduced Schofield, and proudly endorsed his candidacy.

In her endorsement of Schofield, Lawn said: □ Tim Schofield is the right choice for State Senate. He is a person of honesty, character and integrity who will work with dedication and compassion to represent people of all backgrounds in our communities. Tim is a progressive leader who genuinely understands the challenges faced by the elderly, working families, and each and every individual in our district. □

After the event, volunteers knocked doors across the district, which includes parts of Allston-Brighton, portions of the Back Bay and the Fenway in Boston, the towns of Watertown and Belmont, and north and west Cambridge.

Schofield is a Boston attorney who has been active in progressive politics for many years. He served as an issues adviser to former State Senator Warren Tolman, and as Chair of the Boston Ward 21 Democratic Committee. Schofield is active in the Allston-Brighton community and currently serves on

the Board of the Presentation School Foundation. Schofield, who is openly gay, has also served on the Board of the Massachusetts LGBTQ Bar Association.

Schofield is a graduate of Boston College Law School and the University of New Hampshire. He is the youngest of eight children and was the first in his family to attend college. He is a veteran who served in Saudi Arabia during the First Gulf War and worked as a Legislative Aide to former Congressman Richard Swett (D-NH).
